## 2024 ADJUDICATORS

We are honored to welcome the following adjudicators to this year's Lambton County Music Festival:

### **ALDE CALONCAGONG - *Junior & Elementary Piano***



Alde Calongcagong obtained his Bachelors of Music in piano performance from the University of Windsor and his Masters of Music at the University of Western Ontario. His principal teachers include Dr. E. Gregory Butler and Ronald Turini. A former Rose Bowl winner at the Windsor Essex Kiwanis Music Festival, Alde was also the recipient of the J. Francis Leddy Entrance Scholarship, and the Ouellette/Yamaha Piano Scholarship at the University of Windsor. From the University of Western Ontario, he was also a prize winner (top pianist) at the London Music Scholarship

Foundation Competition.

Alde has had the opportunity to perform in masterclass with Jane Coop, Tom Plaunt, John McCabe, Dang Thai Son and Janina Fialkowska. Alde maintains a successful music studio in the Windsor area and has served as a member of the provincial council for the Ontario Registered Music Teachers Association. Many of his students have entered university music programs and have won top prizes and scholarships at local, provincial and national music competitions.

Alde has been active as an adjudicator, sessional music instructor at the University of Windsor, special instructor (piano) at the University of Windsor, choral accompanist for the University Windsor Singers, piano tutor at the Walkerville Centre for the Creative Arts and an examiner for the Royal Conservatory of Music.

Highlights include performances at Koerner Hall and the Glenn Gould Studio in Toronto, and a performance of the Beethoven Choral Fantasy with the Windsor Symphony Orchestra.



**SANDRA MOGENSEN - *Intermediate & Senior Piano***



Sarnia-born and -raised, Sandra Mogensen has extensive pedagogical experience, both as a piano teacher and a coach for singers. A former senior member of the Royal Conservatory of Music Board of Examiners, Sandra is currently an examiner for Canadian National Conservatory of Music and Conservatory Canada. She enjoys adjudicating students of all ages and levels as a way to support and encourage personal and musical development, while sharing her love for music.

As a performer, pianist Sandra Mogensen is equally at home in two worlds: performing as a solo pianist and co-performing with singers in recital. She has played in concert in both capacities in Canada, the United States, and throughout Europe.

In early 2019, Ms. Mogensen's focus turned to the music of female composers. Her first recording in the series of albums known as *en pleine lumière* was released in December 2019, spotlighting composers born in mid-1800s. Volume two (composers born 1870-1900) recording sessions have been postponed due to the pandemic. This series of recordings is of solo piano music by undeservedly overlooked women who composed, from the romantic era up to present day.

She has also co-founded a project called 'Piano Music She Wrote', in which thousands of piano pieces composed by women have been catalogued in an online directory. The 'Piano Music She Wrote' YouTube channel features Sandra's and her co-founder Erica Sipes' performances of some of this music, with a repertoire that continues to expand weekly. Sandra has also recently released two elementary level 'Piano Music She Wrote' anthologies for piano students, published by Debra Wanless.

Sandra's first solo recording, *Piano Music of Edvard Grieg*, recorded in December 2006, was warmly received and praised. Since then, Sandra has become known as a specialist in Grieg's music, having released four recordings of the great Norwegian's music so far.

Sandra is excited to be adjudicating the Lambton County Music Festival, which was such an important part of her early music education.

**MICHELYN WRIGHT - Vocal**



Michelyn Wright received her Honours Bachelor of Music Education, and an Artist's Performance Diploma from the University of Western Ontario then her Master of Music in Voice Performance at the Mannes College of Music in New York City. Through these years she studied with such great teachers as Bernard Diamant, Lois Marshall, Dr. Darryl Edwards and Ruth Falcon. In 1997 she worked with Joan Sutherland and Richard Bonyngé at the Britten Pears School. Michelyn has performed as a soloist with the Guelph Chamber Choir, the Kitchener Waterloo Symphony Orchestra, Toronto Operetta Theatre, and was a chorister with the Canadian Opera Company Chorus from 1998-2008.

Michelyn has been an active Voice Teacher in Markham since 1997. She has been a member of ORMTA since 2017, and is the Markham Stouffville Branch President. A member of the National Assoc. of Teachers of Singing since 1999, she was on the Ontario Chapter executive board for 15 years. In 2001 she was selected as one of 20 applicants to attend the NATS Intensive Program, a teacher training program for young voice teachers. Michelyn has been an Artist Educator with the Canadian Opera Company Education Department, Vocal Music Director for the Unionville Theatre Company and a Vocal Instructor for the Bach Children's Chorus. Currently, Michelyn has a large private voice studio in Markham and is a Sessional Lecturer at the University of Toronto, teaching Voice Education to undergraduate instrumental music education students.

Michelyn's students have been finalists at the OMFA Provincials, NATS Regional Auditions, NATS Ontario Vocal Showcase, Pickering GTA Music Festival, Newmarket Lions, Toronto Kiwanis, and North York Music Festivals and recently the 1st Place winner of the 2021 and 2022 ORMTA Vocal Provincials. Her students have been Silver and Gold Medal Royal Conservatory of Music Winners, and many have continued in music after high school at the University level, attending such schools as, McGill University, University of Toronto, Western University and Wilfrid Laurier University.

**ERIN ARMSTRONG - Choral**



Mezzo-soprano Erin Armstrong is native to Windsor/Essex County and is well known for her ability to captivate an audience with her commanding stage presence and warm, rich voice as well as for her constant community driven performances and creative initiatives. She is a recipient of the Windsor Mayor's Award for Individual Artist, the Elizabeth Havelock Grant for Performing Artist through the Windsor Endowment

for the Arts and a nominee for the Ontario Premiere's Award.

Erin is the founder and director of Music Moves Kids children's choir, summer camps and music theater intensives. Music Moves Kids are recipients of the Performing Arts Infrastructure Grant through the Windsor Endowment for the Arts and have performed on Cogeco TV, PBS and with The Tenors. They have sung in many operas including the Canadian premier of Czech national opera, *Jakobin*, by Dvorak. Other credits include the chorus of Cherubim in *Mefistofele*, the shepherds in *Amahl and the Night Visitors* and the children with the Windsor Symphony Orchestra in Act 2 of *La Boheme*. In 2016 they performed the children's opera *Brundibar*, both at the Windsor and Edinburgh Fringe Festivals. They have been the chorus of *Kuchenkinder* for three productions of *Hansel and Gretel* and appeared as the orphans in *Der Rosenkavalier*. They are frequent guests of the WSO for the Holiday Pops concerts, and they were invited to sing at Carnegie Hall in New York, singing John Rutter's *Mass of the Children*, conducted by John Rutter in 2018.

Erin is also founder and director of *Abridged Opera*, an initiative in Windsor celebrating their ten-year anniversary this spring, designed to bridge the gap for audiences and the world of opera, making the art form more accessible. *Abridged Opera* has produced twenty-three full scale productions, several in partnership with the Windsor Symphony Orchestra, and over forty concerts.

Erin also conducts the UMEI Christian High School Chorus, the Leamington United Church Choir and was the conductor of the Windsor Community Choir for 8 seasons, including the strange online times during the pandemic. She has guest-conducted at Walkerville Centre for the Creative Arts and is an up-and-coming opera director having worked for *Abridged Opera*, the Windsor Symphony and *Opera Idaho*. She has choral adjudicated several festivals including Lambton's own, *Erie Online Festival* and *MusicFest Windsor*. Erin has begun work on three different recording projects to be released in the next 24 months, and is delighted about the creation of her vocal music series. Erin is also delighted to be returning to the operatic stage next season with the Windsor Symphony Orchestra.

Past opera credits for Erin include *Fricka/Schwertleite/Ortlinde* (*Die Walküre*), *Octavian* (*Der Rosenkavalier*), *Beppe* (*L'Amico Fritz*), *Azucena* (*Il Trovatore*), *Dalilah* (*Samson and Dalilah*), *3rd Lady* (*Magic Flute*), *Mother* (*Amahl and the Night*

Visitors), Mother and Witch in (Hansel and Gretel), Fiordiligi (Cosi fan tutte), Old Woman (Candide), Mrs. Grose (The Turn of the Screw), Margherite (Mefistofeles), Heidi Schiller (Follies), Mrs. Andrews (Mary Poppins), Mimi (La Boheme), Violetta (La Traviata), Angelica/La Zia Principessa (Suor Angelica), High Priestess/ Amneris (Aida), La Contessa (La nozze di Figaro), Giulietta (I Capuletti ed I Montecchi), Beth (Little Women), Juliette (Romeo et Juliette), Alice Ford (Falstaff), Rosalinda (Die Fledermaus) and Donna Anna (Don Giovanni). Erin is an alumna of Calgary Opera's Emerging Artist Program and a graduate of the Universities of Windsor and British Columbia. She holds her Bachelor and Masters of Music as well as a Bachelor of Education. Two years ago she embarked on her most important and favourite job yet, being Leo's mom.

### **NICHOLAS PENNY - *Strings***



Violist Nicholas Penny began his violin studies with Benjamin Stolow of the Montreal Symphony Orchestra. A student at Marianopolis College and McGill University, he studied violin with Mauricio Fuks, viola with Stephen Kondaks, and chamber music with Marcel Saint Cyr of the original Orford Quartet. Mr. Penny is based in Windsor Ontario, where he enjoys an active career both as a performer and teacher. He joined the Windsor Symphony Orchestra in 1989 where he has held positions as Assistant Principal and Principal viola. In addition to WSO performances, he can be heard occasionally in local chamber music concerts, notably with 4th Wall Music.

Mr. Penny has worked with young violin and viola students at a wide range ages and levels, from three-year-old beginners to university students, in the capacity of teacher, chamber music coach, and string orchestra conductor.

For many years, Nicholas and his wife Michèle have run Sunnyside Strings, their home studio, where they teach private lessons, Suzuki group lessons, advanced chamber ensembles, as well as holding summer chamber music sessions. Sunnyside Strings students and ensembles perform regularly in the community including WSO main series concerts, and have been award winners at the Kiwanis festival and at OMFA provincial competition. Several Sunnyside Strings laureates have gone on to pursue performance degrees have had successful careers as professional musicians.

Nicholas is currently one of co-lead teachers for the String Project, a new program run by the Greater Essex County District School Board, teaching violin to grade 3 and 4 beginner students in an after-school program.

He has also taught at the University of Windsor and was on the faculty of Huckleberry Music Camp for two decades.

**LINDA WHARTON - *Bands & Instruments***



Linda has an honours Music degree from Western University and an Education degree from Althouse College. She taught secondary school instrumental music for 32 years, in St. Thomas and London. Her bands won many awards locally, regionally, and nationally. Linda also won many teaching awards, including the Award of Distinction from the Thames Valley District School Board and a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Jack Richardson Music Awards. She also served on the Ontario Music Educators' Association Board for 6 years.

Linda is currently teaching Conducting/Instrumental Rehearsal Techniques at Western University and is loving adjudicating around the province and on the East Coast. She also gets to travel the world with her competitive Dragonboat team!
